Finna Stad Art Exhibition

Finda stad is an artistic framework created by the artists Tone Einelia and Petra Rahm, which deals with how art and city are closely related. Tone and Petra have already held several events at Oppdalsøyra in collaboration with junior high school students and committed villagers. In Eivindvik, the artists together with staff and residents have created a sensory space in the nursing home. Here there are monthly meetings for art, crafts, food and conversation. The artists will continue to work in the anniversary year with new collaborations in Byrknes and Brekke. The artists take the meeting of people and what they do together with the local communities in Gulen, into the work of the art exhibition for the anniversary weekend in August.

Hidden Soul of Dreams

This is an artist and music collaboration between Winter Lazarus and Heidi Torsvik, together with guest artists they will give us a concert experience we will not forget.
